

LISBON AGREEMENT FOR THE PROTECTION OF APPELLATIONS OF ORIGIN AND THEIR INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION

WIPO Bulletin *Appellations of origin*: discontinuation of paper version

1. The WIPO Bulletin *Appellations of origin*, hereinafter referred to as “the Bulletin”, the official publication of the Lisbon system, is published periodically by the International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO). It contains all relevant data concerning new international registrations as well as modifications and other entries affecting existing international registrations. The Bulletin also contains information of general interest such as statistical data concerning international registrations and changes to the legal framework of the Lisbon system.
2. Since March 2010, all issues of the Bulletin published up to then – Nos. 1 to 38 – are available online in PDF format, free of charge (at the same time as the paper version, which is distributed by mail on a subscription basis). The electronic version can be found on the Lisbon system website at the following address:

3. Users are hereby informed that the next issue of the Bulletin – No. 39 of January 2011 – will also still be distributed in paper format as well as on line. However, as of issue No. 40, distribution by mail of a paper version of the Bulletin will be discontinued. Distribution of the Bulletin will, from then on, only take place electronically by means of its publication on the Lisbon system website as indicated above.
4. An e-mail alert system will be made available for users who would like to be informed whenever a new issue of the Bulletin has been published. For this purpose, interested users are requested to convey their e-mail address to the International Bureau of WIPO.
